Assessment: Your portfolio will be graded based on the following criteria (1 = unacceptable, 10 = exceptional)

This would include material that you have developed to make the portfolio easier to access and understand (e.g., title pages, tables of content, dividers, narratives, and photographs). Grade is based on the presence and quality of these materials.
